

Joint and Dual Academic Awards

The SACSCOC defines agreements involving joint or dual academic awards as an agreement between UTSA and another degree-granting institution of higher education (accredited or non-accredited) anywhere in the world for purposes of awarding academic credits and/or educational program completion credentials, such as certificates, diplomas, degrees or transcripts. There are currently six SACSCOC-approved agreements for UTSA listed in the table below.
