OVERVIEW

If your camera is displaying upside down or sideways in Zoom on your Windows PC, you can rotate the camera in your settings until it is oriented correctly.

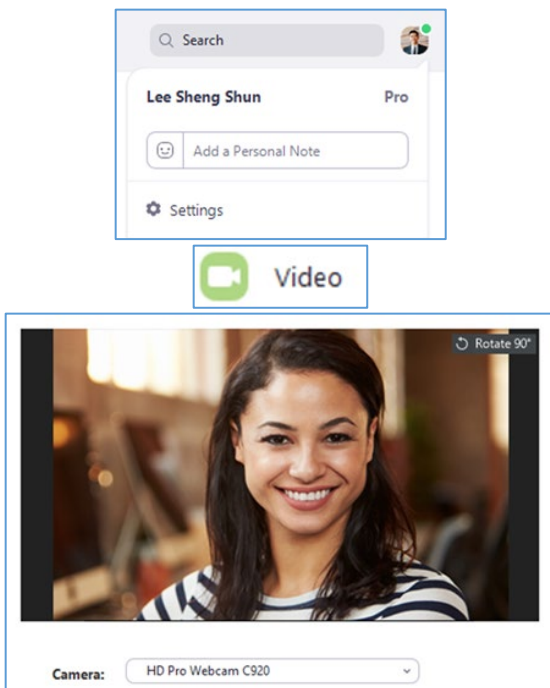

INSTRUCTIONS

How to rotate your camera before a meeting



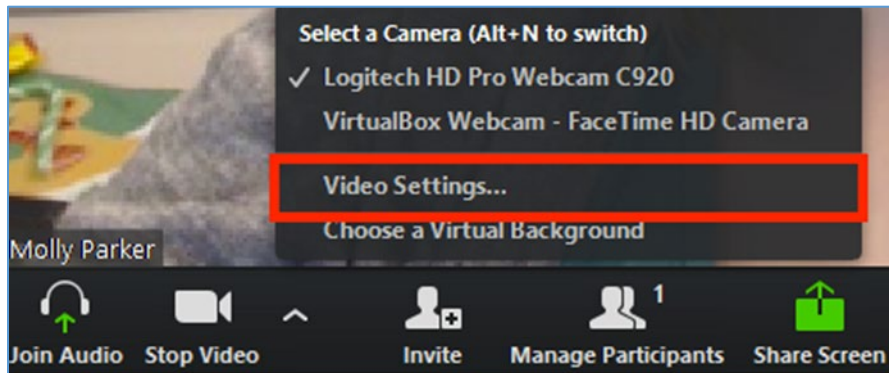
1. Log in to the Zoom client.
2. Click your profile picture then click Settings.
3. Click the **Video** tab.
4. Hover over the preview of your camera.
5. Click **Rotate 90°** until your camera is rotated correctly.

How to rotate your camera while in a meeting

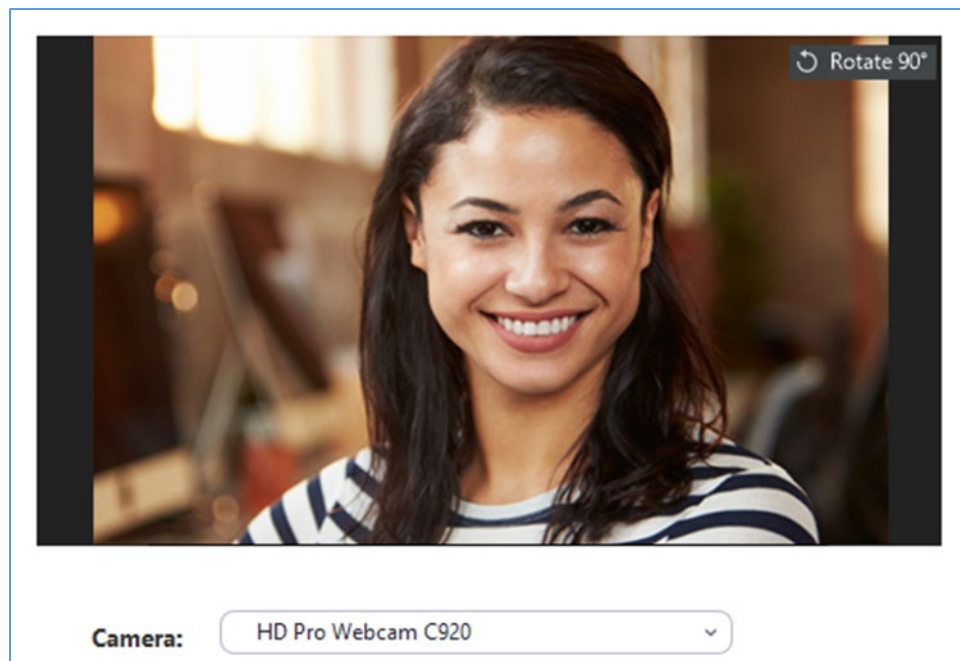
1. Click the arrow next to **Stop Video**.



2. Choose **Video Settings**.



3. Hover over the preview of your camera.
4. Click **Rotate 90°** until your camera is rotated correctly.
