The ability to connect choices, actions and consequences to ethical decision-making.

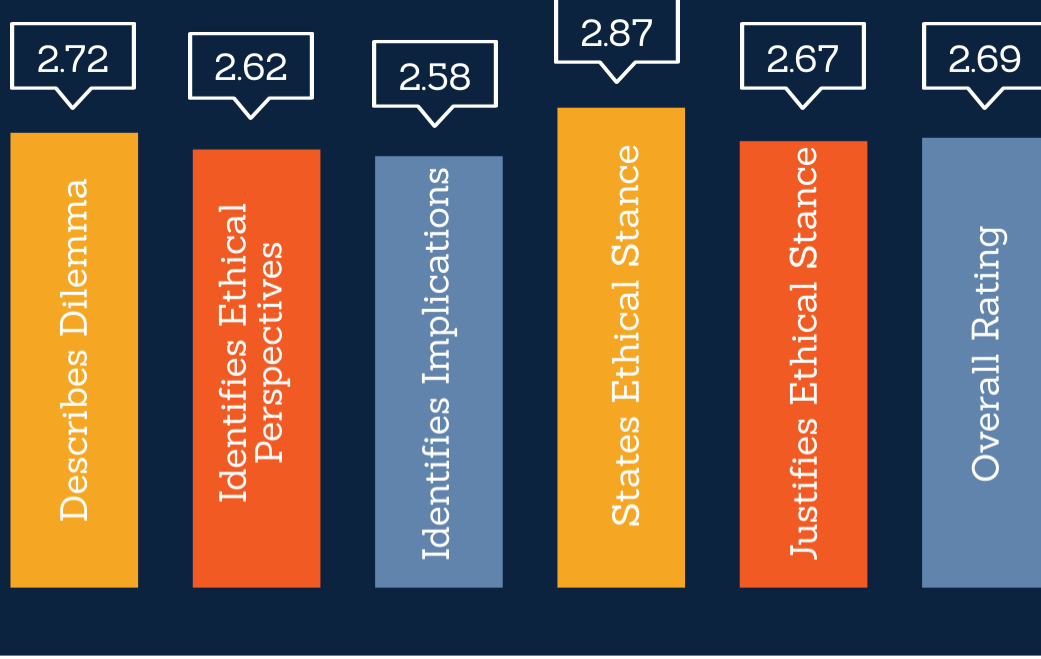
Outcomes

UTSA Student's Performance

Goal: 2.6 on a 1-4 point scale

Results: Approximately 2/3 (64.3%) of students met or exceeded the goal

Recommendations

1. Work closely with Teaching & Learning Services to provide faculty with activities, resources, and experiences to help students identify ethical perspectives and understand implications of ethical decisions.
2. Encourage the Classroom to Career Task Force to include PR components into future initiatives.
3. Connect core coursework with programming and resources within Student Affairs.
